## • ROLL CALL & APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to adopt the Agenda as presented

#### • APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

**On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried** it was resolved to approve the minutes from LISA Board Meeting #2, Sept 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022

# • LISA UPDATE (SB):

- o Numerous schedules being updated weekly
  - o Team movement seems to be more prevalent than previous years



- Juan de Fuca is hosting the Active Start Mini-Fest on October 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>
  - o Draft schedule will be available by the end of the week
  - Thank-you to Karen Thompson for looking after the T-shirts and team packages
- LISA Admin hiring process underway
  - o Between 50 and 60 applications received
  - Have selection process down to 5 candidates
  - o Will be conducting interviews next week
- o Clubs struggling to get Coaches through Coach Education Process
  - Active Start and Fundamentals cancelled at Gorge due to lack of registrants
  - Learn to Train and Soccer For Life went ahead with small numbers
  - Barrier seems to be the online components and timelines for registration
  - Clubs need to track coaches within pathway and approach LISA/Learning Facilitators to host course only when numbers for on-field portion are high enough
- o Overview of "Nimble" online media campaign presented
  - o 66% increase in new users to your site compared to last month and a 47% increase from last year at 2,847 new users
  - Onsite conversion rate increased by 35% vs. last month and most goals were completed by paid social ads
  - We saw a strong click-through rate at 0.83%, up 56% from last month. We've also seen an increase in both impressions and link clicks overall for the month of August
- LISA moving forward with "Buddy Check for Jesse" mental health initiative with all U11-U18 Players near the end of October and early November
- LISA Discipline has seen the usual instances of "Foul and Abusive Language" and the occasional "Denying Obvious Goal Scoring Opportunity"
  - Few issues of Referee Abuse in LISA/UISA Interlocking Matches
- Referee Development Officer submitted proposal for "Stop Referee Abuse" banners for each of our member clubs



 Cost works out to approximately \$6000.00 for 13 sets of banners and signs

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to approve the purchase of the "Stop Referee Abuse" signage for all clubs.

- LISA has received a handful of comments and concerns from smaller clubs regarding the removal of boundaries and the challenges they are facing fielding competitive teams this season as players have moved on
- Mike Synnuck provided an update from the BCSA SGM in which the voting structure referendum was approved

### • BUDGET AND FINANCIALS (AWW)

- Treasurer Wynn-Williams provided a Budget and Financial update including a quarterly Budget review
  - o Clubs have been invoiced for 70% of last season's registration
    - As of now all but two clubs have paid their invoices
  - o LISA payments to BCSA for primary registration upcoming
  - Budget currently on track for Quarter 2
    - LISA has spent more than budgeted on Advertising and Communications as approved by the Board
    - LISA has spent slightly more on Governance Committee and Strategic Planning support than budgeted
    - LISA expecting to pay some Professional Fees for a formal contract in regards to the New Membership Agreement Process
      - a. Recommendation to include "Professional Fees" in future annual budgeting costs
      - b. Recommendation to increase "Strategic Planning" costs for future annual budgets when needed

### • COMMITTEE UPDATES

- Tier 2 Working Committee
  - Recommendation from previous Tier 2 Working Group to downsize committee and begin focus on next season
  - Additional recommendation was for LISA to implement a "Tier
     2 Coordinator" to oversee the administration of the program
- o Island Cup Committee



 LISA in communication with UISA to form joint organizing committee to focus on 2023 tournament

### OTHER BUSINESS

- o VI Wave Financial Support for Nationals
  - VI Wave have removed their request to LISA for Funding for the U17 Boys team competing at the upcoming CSA National Championships
- o BCSA AGM
  - o BCSA AGM scheduled for November 5<sup>th</sup> in Vancouver
  - LISA know carries 4 votes and may send up to 4 Voting Delegates
  - o Mike Synnuck will be attending on behalf of LISA
  - LISA will distribute voting information to member clubs for voting direction
