### **NEW BUSINESS**

## **TECHNICAL REPORT**

- Futsal tournament had 32 boys and 30 girls
  - Recommend that LISA hold the U12 futsal tournament next year
- Soccer for Life course had 19 coaches participating
  - 1 LISA VIPL coach did not attend the course, coach has been removed as the team head coach for the balance of the season
- Not all clubs are putting their coaches through the required Active Start and FUNdamentals coaching courses
  - Wonder if LISA should be back to organizing courses to get as many coaches certified as possible
    - Understandably challenging to coordinate will bring it to the attention of club presidents to see if numbers can go back up
    - If coaches aren't certified, this could cause difficulties if a player is injured and required BC Soccer insurance



#### OFFICE REPORT

- Finances
  - The current LISA registration numbers were reviewed
    - Registration is down slightly from the budget projected registration numbers but not by much
- Roster Checks
  - Currently 40% of the roster checks not successfully completed
    - 2 teams required LISA to request releases for players
      - 1 team was fixed in December
      - 1 team requesting fixing this evening
    - Not all individuals provided proof at the deadline and some still outstanding

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to approve these releases to make this team eligible

- Suggestion for next year is to do it earlier in the season and advise presidents of the results
- A club grandfather request was discussed and approved
- Pacific FC Memo of Understanding
  - Memo was discussed and signed
  - Pacific FC will be hosting a skills centre for elite players starting in the late spring
    - Enrolment for this centre will be limited
- President's Meeting and strategy update
  - President's meeting will be held on Jan 22<sup>nd</sup> at the JdF Library in the boardroom
    - As requested by the presidents, Ann Moskow has been invited to attend to discuss the work on the new LISA constitution and bylaws
- VIPL
  - The Review of Tier 2 Report from Derek Trimmer for the presidents was discussed
    - Decision on the VIPL may take place at the January President's meeting
    - UISA will be advised the presidents are meeting to discuss the commissioned report
- B Cup Draw
  - Random B Cup draw took place

#### **OTHER BUSINESS**

- Director Hughes discussed the Spectrum Turf proposals
  - It has been approved to do a feasibility study
  - Has a great amount of fundraising to do, LISA will not be committing funds except as rental dollars
- Director Pakos
  - Asked if there was any update on the EPIC women's team, nothing new to report, our signed application for associate membership went into BC Soccer
